



Prospectus: Art in Bloom

THEME: Floral designers from the Cornell Cooperative Extension Master Gardeners of Orange County will select works to create floral arrangement interpretations of. Artwork can be of any style or subject EXCEPT FLOWERS. Portraits, landscapes, abstract, etc. are all welcome. Artwork will be displayed alongside the flower arrangements.

DATES: On display June 18, 2021 – June 27, 2021

- **Submissions due: May 27th**
- Notification by: June 4th
- Drop-off by: June 13th
- Reception: June 19th (tentative)
- Pick-up Starts: July 2nd

ART SPECIFICATIONS:

- Work must be original artwork, not previously exhibited at Wallkill River School (WRS).
- We have limited space for large works. Works over 30x30 inches will be considered separately.
- Work must be ready to hang with a WIRE HANGER ONLY (no dogtooth or other styles).
- Works must be framed or have painted or finished edges. Frames must be clean and in good repair.

JURYING:

- Max of 4 submissions per artist.
- Submit via email to info@wallkill.art with the exhibit name in the subject line.
- Include your name and phone number in the email body.
- Include: JPEG image, Title, Medium, Size (in inches, not including the frame), and Price.
- Works will be presented to the juror anonymously as digital images.
- Results, both accepted and unaccepted will be announced via email by the 15th of the month
- Selected works are the choice of the juror and does not necessarily reflect the opinions of WRS.

EXHIBIT TERMS:

- No fee to submit. \$20 hang fee per accepted piece (2 fees waived per show for artist level members).
- Work must be dropped off with a SIGNED prospectus (this document).
- Wallkill River School will take a 30% commission on all art sales.
- The artist can pick up a check for 70% of the sale price within 30 days of show closing.
- Sold work will remain on display until the show closes.
- The artist agrees to exhibit these works and holds harmless the volunteers and staff of WRS.
- Any damage incurred, such as broken glass or wires giving way, is the responsibility of the artist to fix.
- The artist agrees to pick-up unsold works in a timely manner. The Wallkill River School is not responsible for any paintings left in the gallery 30 days after the exhibit closes. Unclaimed works will be considered charitable contributions to our 501(c)(3) non-profit.
- We reserve the right to refuse artwork at any time for any reason.
- In addition to this prospectus, all exhibiting artists must sign our Artists Policies and provide a form W-9 annually.
