Overview of Exhibit Terms:

A commission is collected on all sold artwork, typically 30%. Please See our Exhibiting Artist Policies and prospectus for specific details. A signed and dated copy of the policies and a W-9 must be returned to Walkkill River School before any work can be exhibited. We must also receive a signed and complete prospectus for all gallery shows.

2021 Hallway Themes:

- Group exhibit, lightly curated for compliance with the theme, open to Artist, Joint Artist and Represented Artists.
- No fees, no prospectus required
- Two (2) pieces which meet the theme requirements may be dropped off; one will be hung and the second hung if space allows.
- Works are hung mid-month, usually near the 15th.
- Sign work in and out on the clipboard in the foyer, fill out an art label attach the label to your piece with a tape roll.

Juried Exhibits:

- The works included in juried shows will be selected by the announced juror who is typically an artist or art professional. Not all submitted works will be accepted to the show. Accepted work is the choice of the juror and does not necessarily reflect the opinions of the WRS. Work will be presented to the juror anonymously.
- Submit via **email to info@walkkill.art** with the **show title in the subject line**.
- Include in the body of your email:
 - Your Name
 - Phone Number
 - Title of the Piece
 - Medium
 - Size
 - Price
 - JPG of your piece(s).
- Up to four (4) pieces per show are allowed.
- There is no fee to submit, but there will be a \$20 hang fee per accepted piece.
- Two (2) hang fees per show are waived for Artist, Joint Artist and Represented Artist members.
- Results, both accepted and unaccepted will be announced via email.
- Work **MUST** be checked in at the desk if you do not have an artist membership.

Group Exhibits:

- Group shows are typically un-juried exhibits which are open artists who are in a group or meet certain criteria.
- Our Members Exhibit, Senior Exhibit and Teachers Exhibits are examples of this type of show.
