ELECTION: The following people are running for 7 available seats on the Board of Directors:

- **1. Gloria Bonelli** Gloria is currently serving as Secretary on the Board of Directors. She has worked as an arts administrator and arts advocate since 1979. Gloria Bonelli is the founding principal at Gloria Bonelli and Associates, a talent management firm.
- Conor Eckert Conor has been serving on the Board of Directors since August 2021. Conor
 Eckert is the Executive Director of the Town of Montgomery IDA, and Director of
 Economic Development for the Town of Montgomery, NY. Conor has formal training in
 financial management and budgeting.
- **3. Louise Pedrick** Louise is an artist and retired businesswoman, she is currently volunteering as recording secretary and on the marketing and insurance committees.

PROPOSITIONS: The Board of Directors respectfully asks the members to approve the following two propositions:

- 1. Changing the name of the organization to "Wallkill River Center for the Arts." "The Wallkill River School" is a playful pun on the famous "Hudson River School" art movement, however, we have found that the inclusion of the word "School" in the name of the organization misleads some people into thinking we are an educational institution which issues degrees. Also, it does not seem to represent the full scope of our services, particularly our gallery and exhibit programs which are a key part of our activities. "Wallkill River Center for the Arts" is a substantial and broadly inclusive name which encompasses our gallery activities, community art programs, art classes and paves the way for future growth in other areas of art such as writing, music and performing arts.
- **2. Granting lifetime memberships to the founders of the organization**: Shawn Dell Joyce, Steve Blumenthal and Gene Bove.
